Findings: Asylum Seekers are Victims & Problems




Findings: Politicized Debate



Perpetuating narrow discourse

- Framing: Australian national interest
- Reliance on official sources
- Failure to include the voices of asylum seekers (**9.1%**)
- Prevalence of episodic coverage (**94.4%**)
- Failure to challenge the notion that ***asylum seekers are a problem for Australia (19.6%)***



"I and my fellow detainees came in search of freedom after suffering extreme persecution in our home countries. What has shocked us most is that our human rights have been profoundly violated again, this time by a country that is supposed to respect the principals of human rights. If a western country can do this and get away with it, what hope do we have?"

- Be media skeptical – compound, subtle framing effects
- Focus on people smugglers
 - ignores fundamental questions
 - underscores framing of problem as one of asylum seekers arriving to Australia
- International awareness and advocacy: easier to recognize injustice from a distance

4,565


people arrived by boat to Australia in 2011

~85-90%

of boat arrivals are eventually recognized as refugees

~54,000

visa-overstayers are in Australia illegally




Figure 2.1: Article Topics by Popularity




Figure 2.2: Problems Identified




Figure 2.3: Attribution of Blame




Figure 2.4: Victim Attribution




Figure 3.1: Nature of Coverage




Figure 3.2: Theme Frequency




Figure 3.3: Prescriptions




Figure 3.4: People Smuggler Characteristics




Figure 3.5: Asylum Seeker Characteristics




Figure 3.3: Inclusion of Asylum Seekers' Voices




Figure 3.7: Asylum Seeker-People Smuggler Relationships
